Preston Golf Club LOCAL RULES (revised July 2021)

I. Out of Bounds (OOB)

OOB is defined by the line between the course-side points at ground level of white stakes. OOB is also defined as beyond any course boundary.

The Greenkeepers compound below the 14th tee is OOB. The boundary is defined by the fence & stakes surrounding the area.

2. Abnormal Course Conditions (including Immovable Obstructions) (Rule 16)


- · Ground under repair is defined by any area encircled by a white line
- · Areas in bunkers where sand has been removed by the movement of water resulting in deep furrows through the sand are GUR.
- · Mats that are secured.
- · Pop up sprinkler heads.
- · Areas of green staff vehicle damage.
- · Drains and drain covers.
- All roads and paths on the course, even if not artificially-surfaced. are treated as immovable obstructions.

3. Methods for Stopping and Resuming Play (Rule 5.7b)

A suspension of play for a dangerous situation will be signalled by: I prolonged blast of the air horn. Resumption of play will be signalled by 2 short blasts.

3 consecutive blasts repeated signals play abandoned: course is closed

Red Flag - Front
